Good Manufacturing Practice

In accordance with Regulation (EC) No. 1935/2004 Art. 17 the producer has implemented an appropriate system that enables the traceability of packaging. Pursuant to Regulation (EC) No. 2023/2006, the products are manufactured in accordance with the general principles of good manufacturing practice (GMP).

Adequate information on substances subject to food restrictions, obtained from experimental data or by theoretical calculations of their specific migration level and, where applicable, the purity criteria in accordance with Directives 2008/60/EC, 95/45/EC and 2008/84/EC in order to enable the user of these materials and articles to comply with the relevant EU legislation or, in their absence, with national legislation applicable to food:

The packages to which the declaration refers do not have the "dual use" additives.

Heavy metals

Directive (EC) No 94/62 (including its amendments to Directive (EU) 2013/2) and DL No 152/2006: lead, cadmium, mercury, hexavalent chromium are not intentionally added to the inner film. The inner foil has a total heavy metal content, due to the random sum of the concentrations, less than 100 ppm.

BADGE, BFDGE, NOGE

Regulation (EC) No 1895/2005: BADGE, BFDGE, NOGE are not intentionally used in production or added to production.

Allergens

The substances listed in Annex II to Regulation (EU) No 1169/2011 are not intentionally used in production.

Phthalates

The phthalates are not intentionally added to the packaging. The maximum residue is not more than 15 ppm.

Bisphenol A

The producer certifies that, according to the manufacturer's declaration, the material is Bisphenol A (BPA) free.

PFAS

The producer certifies that, according to the manufacturer's declaration, the material is PFAS (concerning Poly- and Perfluoroalkyl material) free.

Requirements for the use of the material or product

Taking into account the composition and values obtained for the respective global and specific migration, the above packages can be considered suitable for contact with dry, aqueous, acetic, alcoholic and fatty foodstuffs. Ratio of food contact surface area to volume used to establish compliance of a material or article: 6 dm² /1kg

Application restrictions

- The packaging are not intended for heating food in both microwave ovens and ovens (above 60°C)
- The packaging are not intended for cooking (above 100°C) and sterilization
- The packaging cannot be used as a toy for children.

Storage conditions

- Dry, indoor, airy rooms, protected against pests and without foreign smells, away from heating devices and sunlit places.
- Optimum storage temperature 5-35°C
- Protect against frost
- Products should be transported in covered, dry and clean means of transport.
- During transport, pallets with the product should be secured against shifting, crushing and other mechanical injuries as well as the harmful effects of weather conditions.

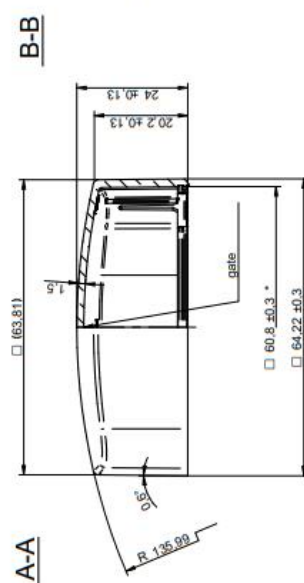

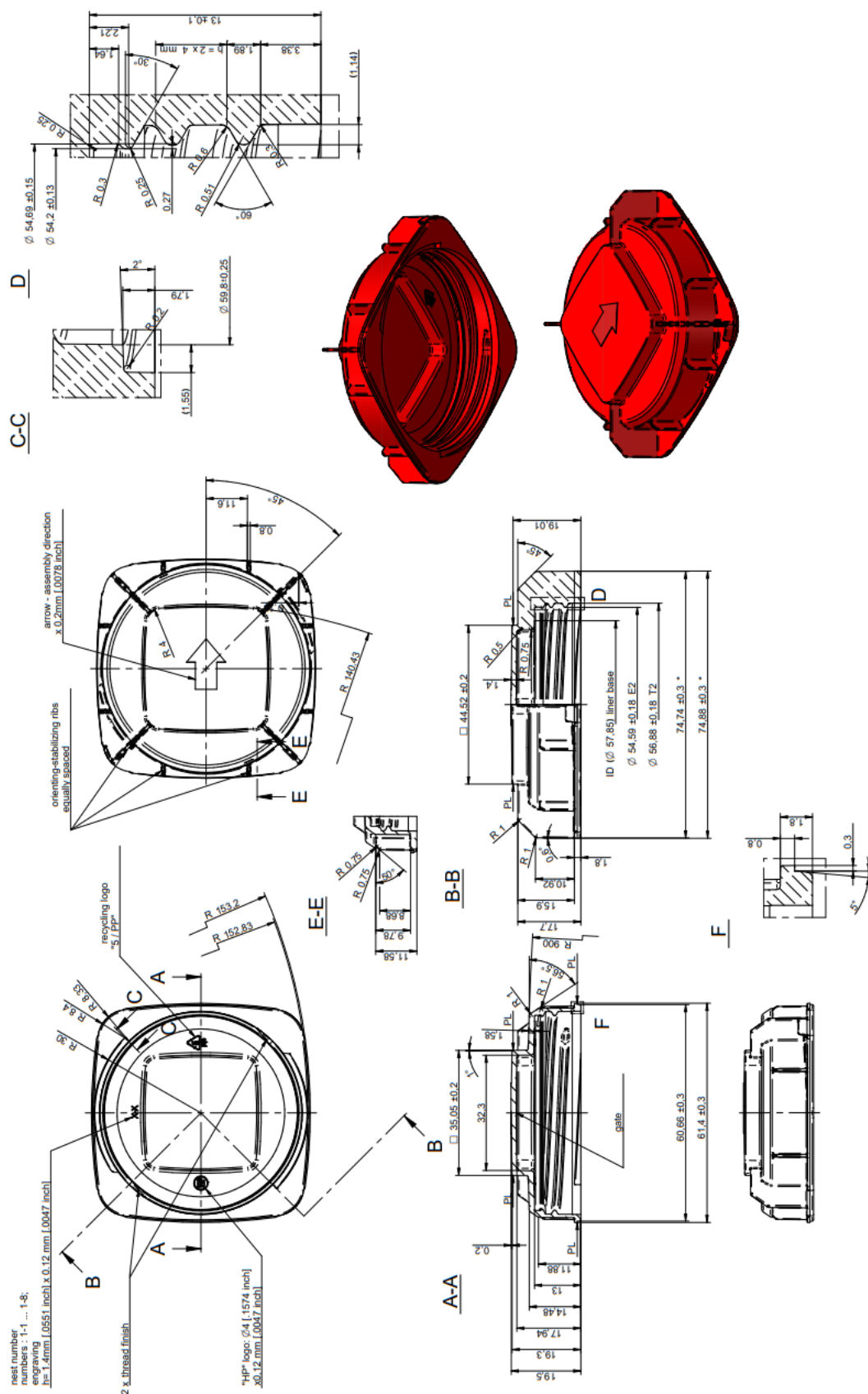
